What is Upward Bound?

Upward Bound is a precollegiate program funded by the U.S. Department of Education and sponsored by Colorado State University. The program has operated at CSU since 1977. Upward Bound assists high school students with academic potential in developing the motivation and skills necessary to succeed in high school and enter college.

Who can participate?

An individual is eligible to apply for Upward Bound if he/she:

- ❖ Is currently a freshman or sophomore in a target high school
- ❖ Is from a family whose taxable income does not exceed the limits set forth by federal regulations governing the program, or if neither parent has earned a four year degree (Bachelor's degree).
- U.S. Citizen or Permanent U.S. Resident
- Has academic potential but needs further development in academics, study skills or college exposure

How does Upward Bound work?

During the school year, Upward Bound provides:

- Regular academic, personal, and college-prep advising for students at their high school, to help students set and reach their goals.
- Saturday sessions (UB University) help improve skills and performance in class and are 1-2 times a semester
- Educational and cultural events and college visits to enrich student's experience and knowledge
- ❖ A stipend for full effort and participation in Upward Bound
- Assistance in securing admission and financial aid for college

During the Summer Program, Upward Bound Provides:

- ❖ A six-week intensive, academic, residential program on the campus of Colorado State University.
- Individualized instruction through classes in math, literature, composition, laboratory science, foreign language, and college preparation
- Recreational, cultural, and personal enrichment activities
- High quality instructional and supervisory personnel
- ❖ A stipend for full effort and participation in the program
