The College of Veterinary Medicine and Biomedical Sciences is excited to offer a week-long residential summer program designed for 9-11 grade high school students interested in careers in science and animal or human health. Students interact with clinicians, CSU professors and student mentors as they explore the veterinary profession and One Health, and will earn one college credit through the accompanying course. Students will also experience hands-on learning in specimen dissection labs, virtual reality labs, and suture clinics, as well as tour the CSU Veterinary Teaching Hospital and interact with veterinarians and other One Health professionals. Students will engage in professional development, including career exploration, resume building, and other skills that can be used for any profession. This experience includes insights about college life, the college application process, and financial aid. ***This Institute is free for students***, with 6 nights of on-campus lodging, meals, and tuition for the course paid by CSU and our corporate sponsor, Zoetis. A \$40 deposit is required to secure their spot once a student is accepted, but will be refunded when students attend the program. Financial assistance for the deposit and travel can be provided upon request.
